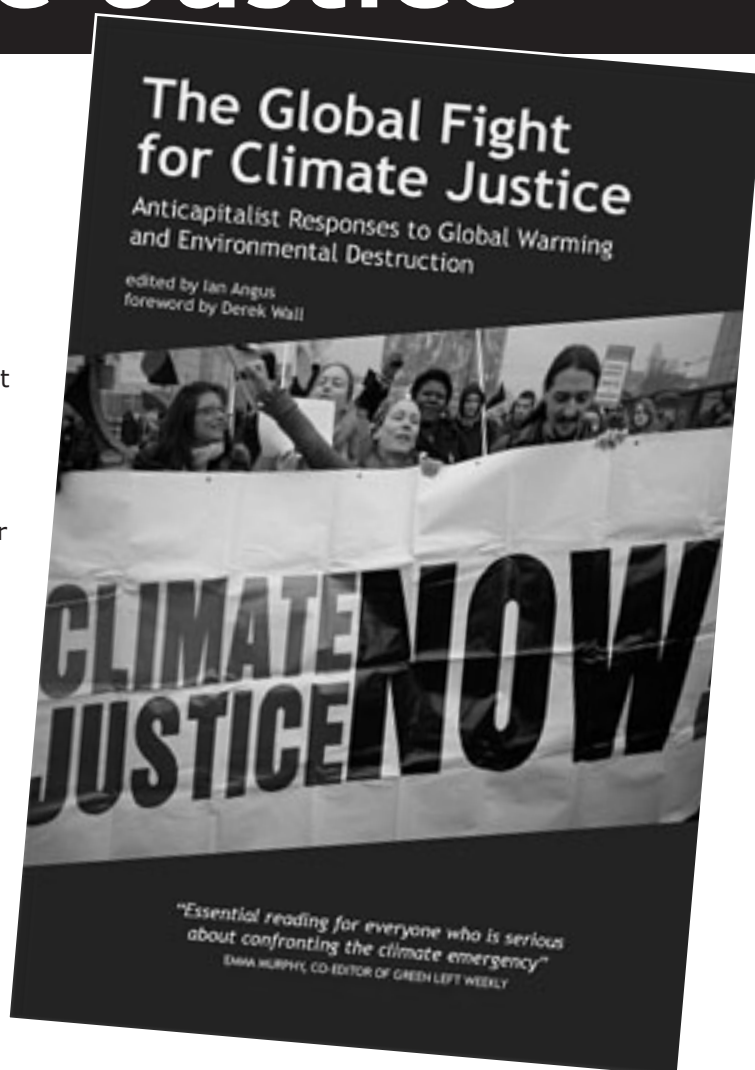
In *The Global Fight for Climate Justice*, anticapitalist activists from five continents offer radical answers to the most important questions of our time:
